Changes at a glance



Prohibition of the placing on the market of all fluorescent lamps in ring form (T5, T9)



Prohibition of the placing on the market of all compact fluorescent lamps with plug-in base (CFLni)



Prohibition of the placing on the market of all T5 and T8 fluorescent lamps



Prohibition of the placing on the market of all halogen pins (G4, GY6.35, G9)
